INTRODUCTION

In this installation guide we have provided step by step instructions to install the CorkSport Performance Rear Floor Chassis Brace

Advisory:

• It is highly recommend to install the brace while the vehicle is on a flat surface.

TOOLS:

- 3/8" Drive Ratchet (1)
- 3/8" Torque Wrench (1)
- 14mm Socket Deep (1)
- 15mm Socket Deep (1)

PARTS:

- CorkSport Rear Floor Chassis Brace (1)
- M10x1.5x45mm Flange Bolts (2)
- M10x1.25x45mm Flange Bolts (2)



Step 1 — Getting Started

- How To Use These Instructions
 - The instruction format will relate colored marking in the image to the color dot in the text to the right of the image
 - Going forward we will be referencing the rear floor chassis brace as just the "brace"
- The vehicle used in these instructions was a highly modified 2006 Mazdaspeed 6. Vehicles with less modifications & Mazda 6 vehicles will be very similar.
- Accessing the brace mounting locations is different for MS6 and Mazda 6. These sections are separated.

Step 2 — Mazdaspeed 6 Accessing Mounting Locations Part 1





- If you have a Mazda 6, skip to Step 4
- Open your trunk and locate the panel that covers the backside of the rear seats
- Remove the 5 push clips that are holding the panel in position, then remove the panel from your trunk
- The trunk will appear like the second image
- Vehicle used for installation images had a battery relocation to the trunk. Your vehicle will not have the large wires shown

Step 3 — Mazdaspeed 6 Accessing Mounting Locations Part 2







- Look at the bottom of the trunk structure in the areas shown to find the rear seat latches
- Rear seat latches appear as shown in second image
- Push the pin shown in the direction shown and push the rear seats forwards to fold down the rear seats
- Seats will fold down as shown in the third image. The bolts that will be used to mount the brace are located at the yellow arrows

Step 4 — Mazda 6 Accessing Mounting Locations







- If you have a Mazdaspeed 6, skip this step
- Fold down the rear seats using the release handles in your trunk
- Pick up the front edge of the trunk carpet as shown, right behind the rear seats. You will see the mounting locations
- Brace mounting locations shown

Step 5 — Removing the OEM Bolts







- Using a 14mm socket and ratchet, remove the two OEM bolts in the locations shown
- (i) These are the outermost rear seat mounting bolts
- These bolts will not be reused.

Step 6 — Rear Floor Brace Installation







- Position the CorkSport Rear Floor Brace ends into the areas the bolts were removed from in the previous step
- The brace can install in either direction.
- Using the supplied bolts, secure the brace to the vehicle:
 - Mazdaspeed 6: Use M10x1.25x45mm bolts
 - Mazda 6: Use M10x1.5x45mm bolts
 - ① The 1.25 bolts have threads that are closer together than the 1.5 bolts
- Tighten the bolts to **30-35ft-lbs**. using a 14mm or 15mm socket and ratchet (size depends on bolt used)

Step 7 — Installation Wrap Up



- Mazdaspeed 6 owners can reinstall the rear seat cover panel and fold up their rear seats
- Mazda 6 owners can replace the carpet that was pulled up earlier and fold up their rear seats.
- Double check tightness of all fasteners after a few days of driving.

Step 8 — Installation Complete



- This completes your installation of the CorkSport Performance Rear Floor Chassis Brace!
 - Listen for any strange noises upon first drive. If any are present, inspect the brace to ensure all components are tight.
