Pre-Installation Notes:



Warning: Turn off your engine and allow the vehicle to cool for at least 30 minutes. Engine coolant can reach temperatures of 200° Fahrenheit or higher.

Installation Instructions:

- Park vehicle on a level surface and let it cool. Let the engine fully cool before starting the install. The engine and surrounding engine components can be very hot. Use extreme caution!
- 2. Remove the Stock Radiator Cap.
 - A. Open the hood and locate the radiator and radiator cap.
 - B. Remove the old cap.
- 3. Install the CorkSport Radiator Cap
 - A. Replace the cap with the new one and turn it clockwise, getting it as tight as you can.
 - B. Start engine, fully warm up car, and keep the hood popped. Keep at a safe distance from the radiator and inspect the cap for discharge or bubbling around the edges.
