Detailed Instructions

- **These installation instructions were written using a 2011 Mazda2.** Other year Mazda2 models will be similar.
- 1. Installing the CorkSport Short Shift Plate.
 - a) Remove the battery cables from the battery with a ²⁰
 10mm wrench. Shown with Green arrows in Figure 1a.
 - b) Remove the battery tie down with a 10mm deep socket or end wrench. You do not have to take the nuts all the way off to remove the tie down. Shown with red arrows in Figure 1a.
 - c) Remove the battery and carefully place it off to the side.

- Removed the battery tray by removing the (3) three
 10mm bolts from the bottom of the tray. Shown circled in Figure 1b.
- e) Remove the cable end from the shifter arm. Pop off the shifter cable from the shifter arm using a 13mm open ended wrench or Large flat head screw driver. Slide the wrench under the edge of the shifter cable and push down on the wrench to force the cable to pop off the ball stud. Be careful not to damage the cable. Shown in Figure 1c.





Figure 1cf) Install the ball stud on the plate in the hole. Use the supplied 10mm flange nut.

g) Place the Short shift plate on the transmission arm looping the factory shifter cable location and aligning the bolt on the shifter shown circled in Figure 1d.

- 1. Installing the CorkSport Short Shift Plate Continued...
 - h) Install the Two 10mm bolts and nuts to secure the shifter on factory arm. Shown circled in Figure 1e. Tighten to 8ft.lbs. Do Not Over Tighten.
 - i) Install the provided 10mm bolt and nut to hold the shift plate down and from twisting. Tighten the 10mm bolt and nut so that the shifter can not move. Tighten to 8ft.lbs. Do Not Over Tighten.
 - j) Install the shifter linkage on the ball stud of the Corksport shift plate. Shown Figure 1d and Figure 1e.
 - k) Reinstall the battery tray. Tighten the 10mm bolts on the tray

- I) Reinstall the battery and battery tie down
- m) Reinstall the battery cables. Install the positive cable first before installing and tightening the negative cable.

This completes the installation of your CorkSport Short throw shift. The shifter should require very little effort to move and should shorten the throw forward and backwards by around 30%. If the cables feel hard to move make sure nothing is binding between the cables were the short shifter was installed. Check out our knowledgebase for additional install information
